- 7. Article 5: Clarified removal process from the BoT
- 8. Article 5: Changed Quorum rules
- 9. New Article 5: Require the BoT to develop, oversee and uphold the Mission and Vision of the association.
- 10. Article 6 Executive: Added Secretary for Youth and Children
- 11. Article 6: Expanded roles: Communications and Technology; Development and Quality Assurance; Finance and Fundraising
- 12. New-Article 6: Defined Ambassadors and their eligibility and appointment
- 13. Article 6: Clarified removal process from the Executive
- 14. New-Article 6: Added a Transition period after elections
- 15. New- Article 7 UNAA Council: Added election of Council leadership
- 16. New-Article 7: Added proportional representation based on membership
- 17. Article 7: Removed action by UNAA Council without meeting
