Dear UNAA Members,

2021 Election Day is fast approaching. UNAA members, as you prepare to vote for your future leaders be cautious of disinformation. Candidates, the final days of the Elections are important, it's your responsibility to give the public accurate, and evidence based information to make informed Election decisions.

### Voter's Checklist—

#### Things To Do Before Election Day:

- Confirm you are registered to vote several weeks before Election Day.
- Provide correct information if your address, or names have changed.
- Know the voter requirements early.
- Know your polling place and how to get there.
- Know what time the polls open and close.
- Become acquainted with the candidates and issues on the ballot.
- Consider becoming a poll volunteer on election day.

- You must make sure you have **valid identification, state or government ID** issued that proves your residency in North America and Canada.
  - Government IDs such as passports/military will not be allowed.
- Only authenticated voters who appear on the **UNAA 2021 voter's register** will be allowed to vote.
  - a) Commissioners will authenticate voters based on their valid state IDs.
  - b) One-man-one-vote: Each authenticated voter is allowed to vote just once.
  - c) Voters will be able to sign in and sign out as they exit.
  - d) Voting day is **September 4, 2021**. Time: **12:00 pm EST**. Stop at **6:00 p. m. EST** and, **Sunday, September 5, 2021**: Start at **9:00 am EST**. and End at **4:00 p.m. EST** (Look out for voting signs for room location).
    - Arrive early to vote to avoid long lines.
